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Sustainability and traceability are becoming more and more important to us and to our guests so look for the symbols below on the list to help you choose a wine most suited to you.

ORGANIC (Org)

Organic Wine is made with no added synthetic pesticides, herbicides or any other chemicals like artificial fertilisers. The wines are accredited by the country's relevant organisation such as The Soil Association of Britain. Many more producers operate to "organic principles" but may be too small or too stubborn to go through the rigorous certification process.

VEGETARIAN (V)

It may seem that a beverage made from pressed and fermented grapes should be vegetarian, but animal derivatives can be used in fining process, such as Isinglass for example.

VEGAN (Ve)

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SUSTAINABLY PRODUCED (SP)

Sustainable Wine growing is a comprehensive set of practices that are environmentally sound, socially equitable and economically viable. They work to conserve energy, maintain healthy soil, protect air and water quality, enhance relations with communities, preserve ecosystems and improve the vitality of vineyards and wineries. Different wine regions have different challenges and each country has their own certifying body.

RECOMMENDED BY THE HOUSE

M. CHAPOUTIER LES VIGNES DE BILA- HAUT BLANC

Côtes Du Roussillon, France

Citrus aromas of lemon and grapefruit with subtle smoky notes. Fresh and very aromatic. A round mouthfeel, with great acidity finished with saline hints and sea shell minerality.

M. CHAPOUTIER MIRABEL. VIOGNIER

Southern Rhône Valley, France

Golden in colour with textbook Viognier notes of apricots, pear and marmalade. Exotic, complex and perfumed, with lively, clean, dry style on the finish. This blending of roundness and freshness is characteristic of Viognier from these volcanic soils.

M. CHAPOUTIER SCHIEFERKOPF RIESLING

Baden, Germany

Amazingly aromatic with citrus, pineapple and mineral notes. Zippy acidity to balance the most subtle off-dry character.

RECOMMENDED BY THE HOUSE

M. CHAPOUTIER LES VIGNES BILA- HAUT ROUSSILLON ROUGE

Côtes Du Roussillon, France

The dominant Syrah grape gives this wine dark and violet hues with flavours of plum and blackberry. Grenache adds white pepper notes and Carignan is responsible for the elegant minerality. Ethereal notes of spices, herbs and mocha linger in the background while hints of black cherry and dark chocolate are woven into a mouth filling wine.

M. CHAPOUTIER CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE LA BERNARDINE ROUGE

Southern Rhône Valley, France

Crimson in colour with a complex nose of blackcurrant and plum followed by roasted coffee and cinnamon, red cherry and Morello cherry. A spicy palate with liquorice, pepper and clove.

M. CHAPOUTIER CROZES-HERMITAGE, 'LES MEYSONNIERS'

Northern Rhône Valley, France

The nose bursts with blackcurrant and raspberry, followed by violet aromas. Ample and round in the mouth, finishing on flavours of sumptuous stewed fruits and vanilla.

M. CHAPOUTIER BANYULS RIMAGE AOC ROUGE

Roussillon, France

Stewed fruits subtly influenced by cocoa with sumptuous balance between the strength of the wine and the finesse of its tannins. The perfect pairing with black fruit desserts and chocolate.



Champagne Ayala has been specially selected as the House Champagne of
Brend Hotels. It is owned by the Bollinger family and is one of the longest
established champagne houses, based in the town of Ay since it was founded in 1860.
Ayala Champagne was first awarded the Royal Warrant by Edward VIII in 1908 and for
over a century Ayala has been the house Champagne of many a British institution.

**Ayala Champagne is known for its Chardonnay driven, fresh and elegant wines,
crafted on a boutique scale by Caroline Latrive. The low dosage and delicate style

CHAMPAGNE

01. AYALA BRUT MAJEUR (SP)

France, Champagne

Light gold in colour, with a delicate mousse. The nose unveils expressive notes of citrus and white fruits. Ayala has been owned by Bollinger since 2005 and has grown up to be the chic little sister. The style is one of modernity exemplified by their grower relationships and the use of stainless steel in the production of their Chardonnay led style. Also one of the only houses to have a female Chef de Cave-Caro-line Latrive.

02. AYALA ROSE MAJEUR (SP)

France, Champagne

Delicate and tangy, light, frothy mousse. Ayala is one of the only large houses to produce a Chardonnay dominated Rose. This wine therefore displays characteristics of grapefruit and blood orange with a lip-smackingly dry finish.

03. AYALA BLANC DE BLANCS (SP)

France, Champagne

Produced in small quantities, only in exceptional vintages and then aged for 6 years. Light yet voluptuous and vibrant, showing a silky texture and a touch of raciness. Citrus, white flowers culminate in a long tight finish from the low dosage.

France, Champagne

Bollinger is one of the oldest family houses still in existence in Champagne, steeped in history and tradition. Methods have little changed and their wines are truly outstanding. Pinot Noir is the backbone of this house, giving richer flavours, further enhanced by their unique use of cask.

07. CHIO ROSE SPUMANTE (V)

Italy, Veneto

Light delicate pink Italian sparkling wine with soft summer berry hints and refreshing smooth bubbles.

The wine has a round and expressive palate, full and grippy with a zesty acidity. It finishes with a long burst of mineral and lime flavours and a Sancerre-like tang.

South Africa, Constantia

Intense red and black fruit with notes of cinnamon spice on the nose. Full bodied and savoury with a well-integrated oak component, ending with a long and rich finish. The blend is dominated by king of the red grapes-Cabernet and further enhanced with Shiraz, Malbec and Petit Verdot.

Spain, Rioja

Made from bush vines 15-30 years old which are low yielding but produce quality concentrated fruit. The nose is bursting with aromas of cherries, redcurrants and blackberries. Argentina, Mendoza

It bursts with aromas of ripe red fruits, plums and redcurrants, along with integrated oak influences. It shows good concentration, and has a complex and wonderfully persistent finish.
