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Sustainability and traceability are becoming more and more important to us and to our guests so look for the symbols below on the list to help you choose a wine most suited to you.

ORGANIC (Org)

Organic Wine is made with no added synthetic pesticides, herbicides or any other chemicals like artificial fertilisers. The wines are accredited by the country's relevant organisation such as The Soil Association of Britain. Many more producers operate to "organic principles" but may be too small or too stubborn to go through the rigorous certification process.

VEGETARIAN (v)

It may seem that a beverage made from pressed and fermented grapes should be vegetarian, but animal derivatives can be used in fining process, such as Isinglass for example.

VEGAN (Ve)

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SUSTAINABLY PRODUCED (SP)

Sustainable Wine growing is a comprehensive set of practices that are environmentally sound, socially equitable and economically viable. They work to conserve energy, maintain healthy soil, protect air and water quality, enhance relations with communities, preserve ecosystems and improve the vitality of vineyards and wineries. Different wine regions have different challenges and each country has their own certifying body.

CHAMPAGNE

01. AYALA BRUT MAJEUR (SP)

France, Champagne

The nose unveils expressive notes of citrus and white fruits. The style is one of modernity, precision and elegance.

02. AYALA ROSÉ MAJEUR (SP)

France, Champagne

The nose displays aromas of strawberries, raspberries and morello cherries together with nuances of spice. Light, fresh and well-balanced with flavours of red gooseberry and raspberry lingering on the finish.

03. AYALA BLANC DE BLANCS (SP)

France, Champagne

Striking, voluptuous and vibrant, with a delicate nose of pomelo, white fruit and frangipani flowers. On the palate, notes of passionfruit, citrus and peaches. The finish is tightly wound with chalky minerality.

04. BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE (SP)

France, Champagne

The nose is aromatic and complex with ripe fruit and spices. Roasted apples, apple compote and peaches burst on the palate. Brioche and walnut linger on the finish. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity.

05. BOLLINGER GRANDE ANNÉE (SP)

France, Champagne

The nose is full and expressive. Apricot, almond and hazelnut, followed by notes of honey and pastry intertwining in a symphony of aromas and flavours. Exceptional texture and structure with a long, silky finish.

PROSECCO & SPARKLING

07. CHIO ROSE SPUMANTE (V)

Italy, Veneto

Delicate pink with fine perlage. Fresh fruity, floral and fun!

08. CHIO PROSECCO DOC (V)

Italy, Veneto

Fruity flavours of apple, melon and pear mingle with a gently floral note. The mousse is fine frothy and persistent.

09. CHIO PROSECCO DOCG (V)

Italy, Veneto

This is a fruit-filled wine, expressing pear and apple flavours and a touch of nuttiness. It has more complexity and finesse than a DOC Prosecco due to the uniquely hilly aspect and mineral-rich soil of Asolo, known as 'The Pearl of Treviso.

Spain, Catalonia

Pale bright yellow colour, refreshing tropical notes and elegant citrus hints.

12. WINSTON HILL ZINFANDEL ROSÉ

USA, California

A major crowd pleaser from the sunshine state. Luscious strawberry ice cream on the nose supported by a bright berry fruited palate and an off-dry finish. Deliciously juicy!

13. PETIRROJO PAIS (V) (SP)

Chile, Colchagua

Made from Pais a unique grape which has played an important role in the Chilean wine-making industry. Pale salmon in colour, showing flowers and red berry aromas.

14. AIX ROSÉ (VG) (SP)

France, Provence

AIX is the epitome of fabulous sophistication and quality. The nose is fresh and fragrant, delicately youthful, and offers classy notes of watermelon, strawberries and flowers. Made to drink with friends and family all day long!

Marlborough, New Zealand

Rongopai translates to 'good taste' or 'good feeling' in Maori. Aromas of orchard fruits and ripe citrus with a hint of strawberry. Soft, well fruited entry, with peach, apple and melon leading with a juicy finish.

17. SOTHERTON CHARDONNAY

Australia, Southern Eastern

Ripe citrus and apple flavours with a refreshing crisp finish.

18. LA JOYA GRAN RESERVA SAUVIGNON BLANC

(V) (SP)

Chile, Colchagua

La Joya, meaning 'the jewel,' is the flagship wine of this boutique, family owned vineyard. The wine is full of smooth mineral notes, bright citrus aromas of grapefruit, lime and orange peel. Long and mouth-watering finish.

19. CASTELLO DI GABBIANO PINOT GRIGIO (SP)

Italy, Veneto

Floral notes caress the nose, with nuances of pear and honeydew melon. Citrus flavours are evident on the palate, alongside crunchy green apple and pear. This wine finds an excellent harmony of fruit and acid, with a slightly nutty almond finish.

Germany, Rheinhessen

A sweeter option with notes of apricot, fleshy peach and pear.

21. THE CROSSINGS AWATERE VALLEY SAUVIGNON BLANC (V) (SP)

New Zealand, Marlborough

This wine shows lifted notes of gooseberry and passionfruit, underpinned with citrus zing. The palate is full with pure fruit flavours, yet balanced with a persistent, crisp mineral finish.

22. DOMAINE CHANSON CHABLIS (V)

France, Burgundy

Delicate floral fragrances mingle with an abundance of citrus fruit. The wine is tight and tense with a good structure and a refreshing mineral finish.

23. LANGLOIS SANCERRE (SP)

France, Loire Valley

Pale yellow. A very expressive nose. Floral and citrus notes of grapefruit. On the palate, very good balance and freshness with a pleasant saline finish.

Germany, Baden

Gold colour with varietal aromas of citrus, spices, pineapple. Zippy acidity and an aromatic finish.

25. LANGLOIS CHATEAU DOMAINE DE GRAND MAISON MUSCADET

France, Loire Valley

Delicate aromas of stone and citrus fruit with a palate of everything you would want from a Muscadet of this quality; fresh, fruity, bone dry with a salty tang on the finish.

26. LA LANCELOTTA GAVI (V) (SP)

Italy, Piemonte

Fresh citrus and stone fruit aromas, with lightly floral notes. The palate has apple and pear characters balanced by hints of apricot, white spice and crisp lemony acidity on the finish.

28. DOMAINE CHANSON MEURSAULT (V) (SP)

France, Burgundy

This well-crafted wine is pure and tight but with plenty of personality. Fresh, zesty aromas and flavours develop into vanilla and hazelnut nuances balanced out by a wet stone finish.

29. KEN FORRESTER CHENIN BLANC

South Africa, Stellenbosch/Somerset West

Full bodied and complex. Dried apricots, pineapple and hints of vanilla and honey.

30. ORUBE RIOJA BLANCO (SP)

Rioja, Spain

White peach and a tropical fruit freshness lead to rich nuttiness and a lick of coconut from the oak.

Creamy and unctuous in texture. A real gem.

31. CAMEL VALLEY BACCHUS (Ve) (V) (SP)

UK, Cornwall

Dry, delicate, pale lime-green in the glass with white peach and nuances of grape on the nose. Succulent palate displaying greengage with hints of mango and tangerine.

32. LAURENT MIQUEL 'SOLAS' VIOGNIER

France, Languedoc

Solas Viognier is a well-balanced, food-friendly wine with a medium body and a light bright characteristic fruit flavours of apricot and peach. Aromas of exotic fruit with hints of almond and honeysuckle on the finish.

34. FERTUNA DROPELLO SANGIOVESE BIANCO (SP)

Italy, Tuscany

A unique wine made from Sangiovese but vinified as a white wine. A delicate floral bouquet, with soft notes of herbs and white fruits. On the palate the wine is fresh, dry and mineral.

36. CLOS DU BOIS CHARDONNAY (SP)

USA, California

Scents of warm apple pastry rise from the glass with touches of honey and toasted oak. Bright layers of freshly sliced pear and ripe apple with zests of citrus carry through the long finish where vanilla and butterscotch come to the fore.

37. YOU & ME ALBARINO (V) (SP)

Spain, Rias Baixas

There are fruity notes, floral white petal notes, and tropical notes, such as pineapple and kiwi. On the palate the acidity reinforces its freshness and liveness and at the same time the fruit and tropical notes linger on the palate.

38. KLEIN CONSTANTIA METIS SAUVIGNON BLANC (SP)

South Africa, Constantia

Made with 'minimal interference,' this wine has an engaging bouquet of nettle, pressed flower, grass clipping and petrichor scents. Hints of passionfruit and orange pith marry with the gooseberry and malic notes.

39. JEAN-LUC COLOMBO PICPOUL BLANC

France, Languedoc

An organic wine from a family producer. This wine has a rich but subtle nose, with fresh notes of white flowers. Nicely rounded on the palate with flavours of lemon and grapefruit.

40. BOUCHON BLOC SERIES SEMILLON

Maule, Chile

The Bouchon Block Series is dedicated to expressing the unique character of a place. This Semillon comes from two select plots in one of the Maule Valley's coolest spots. The 80-year-old vines here are cooled Pacific Ocean breezes, giving the wine a distinct freshness.

Expect aromas of ripe lemon and orange peel, with a silky texture and crisp finish.

41. RAWSONS RETREAT CHARDONNAY SEMILLON (LOW ALCOHOL 0.5%) (SP)

Australia, South East

Sourced from carefully selected fruit parcels, this low alcohol Semillon Chardonnay is crisp and vibrant. Fresh tropical and citrus fruit flavours spread across the mid palate. Melons, lemons and limes are easily detected followed by crisp rounded acidity and a slight tartness.

42. SOTHERTON SHIRAZ (Ve)

Australia, South Eastern

Juicy plums and blackberry flavours, with a smooth, rounded finish.

43. LA JOYA GRAN RESERVA MERLOT (V) (SP)

Chile, Colchagua

Bright clear purple colour with a medium body. Nose is rich in red fruit like strawberries, mushrooms and moist earth. Mouth acidity and floral aftertaste give a persistent and elegant finish.

44. M. CHAPOUTIER LA BERNARDINE CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE (SP)

France, Rhône Valley

Intense crimson red. On the nose complex and subtle blackcurrant and plum notes followed by roasted coffee and cinnamon.

46. PENFOLDS KOONUNGA HILL SEVENTY SIX SHIRAZ-CABERNET (SP)

Australia, Eden Valley

Notes of plum, blackberry, blackcurrant and blueberry. Delicious chocolate and sweet spice notes add to its character and length.

47. GABBIANO CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA (SP)

Italy, Tuscany

A Fruity palette with tobacco and further earthy and spicy notes; balanced firm tannins and a fresh acidity. A Wine of good nerve and great balance.

48. THE CROSSINGS AWATERE VALLEY

PINOT NOIR (V) (SP)

New Zealand, Marlborough

This expressive Pinot Noir has lifted aromas of black plums and violets. Ripe berry fruit flavours combine with savoury notes on the palate to produce a wine that is both elegant and approachable.

49. MOUTON CADET RES GRAVES ROUGE (VG) (SP)

France, Bordeaux

From the highly acclaimed Rothschild Estate. Flavours of ripe black fruits, Christmas spice, prominent tannins and rich complexity.

50. BLASON DE L'EVANGILE POMEROL (SP)

France, Bordeaux

Blason de l'Evangile Pomerol is made from grapes grown in Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite)'s vineyards with the same care and attention as the Grand Vins but made from the younger vines. This allows for a fresher, and less aged style of classic top notch Bordeaux.

51. CHÂTEAU BLACERET ROY BEAUJOLAIS VILLAGE

France, Beaujolais

Bright and lively red, this youthful, juicy Beaujolais has plenty of lifted red fruit. Crushed red berries on the palate with floral notes and a dusting of allspice.

52. DOMAINE CHANSON GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN (V) (SP)

France, Burgundy

Intense aromas of blackberries mixed with spices and a hint of vanilla. Well-structured and dense with a deep and complex texture. There is a hint of minerality on the finish with well integrated tannins.

53. TURKEY FLAT SHIRAZ (V) (SP)

Australia, Barossa Valley

This wine showcases a restrained power, coupled with fine tannins and a lingering finish. Flavours of boysenberry, blackberry, violet, earth, clove, toast and cedar wood.

54. FONTANAFREDDA BAROLO DI SERRALUNGA D'ALBA (V)

Italy, Piemonte

A Clear cut, intense nose with overtones of vanilla and spices. The palate is dry, but soft, full bodied, velvety and well balanced.

South Africa, Somerset West

Packed with dark cherry fruit with hints of mint and a wisp of smoke.

CONTEMPORARY RED WINES

56. CHÂTEAU CHAMAILLE COTES DU BOURG

Bordeaux, France

In this mouth this red wine is powerful with a nice balance between acidity and tannins.

57. LA JOYA SINGLE VINEYARD MALBEC (V) (SP)

Chile, Colchagua

Deep and clean ruby red colour with violet hues. Nose driven by lavender and dark flower notes, ripe black fruit and an unctuous texture balanced by freshness.

58. FERTUNA PACTIO SANGIOVESE CABERNET SAUVIGNON MERLOT (SP)

Italy, Tuscany

Unbelievable Super Tuscan with red cherry fruit, vanilla hints and great structure born out of a joint venture between Giuseppe Maregalli and the Marchese Nicolò Incisa della Rocchetta of Sassicaia.

59. KLEIN CONSTANTIA ESTATE RED (SP)

South Africa, Constantia

Intense aromas of black and red fruit burst on the nose followed by a delicate wood spice. The rich and complex palate is balanced with bold tannins and an elegant backbone. The wine concludes with a long velvety finish.

60. BODEGAS RODA SELA RIOJA (VG) (SP)

Spain, Rioja

The nose is bursting with red fruit aromas of cherries, redcurrants and blackberries. The palate is elegant with lively, fresh flavours. The wood is well-integrated and the finish is persistent.

61. ME & YOU TEMPRANILLO (V) (SP)

Spain, Ribera Del Duero

On the palate it is light and soft. Its medium acidity gives it a fresh mouthfeel, without any harshness and well balanced with the alcohol level. It opens up with good levels of pleasant fruitiness. Overall light in the finish.

62. RAWSONS RETREAT CABERNET (LOW ALCOHOL 0.5%) (SP)

Australia, South East

Concentrated blackberries and red fruit, soft, firm, and rounded with natural fruit sweetness and spice.

63. FINCA FLICHMAN DEDICADO TUPUNGATO MALBEC (V) (SP)

Argentina, Mendoza

Concentrated red fruit flavours of plums and redcurrants. Complex and persistent finish. An excellent example from a highly rated region.

65. BOUCHON CANTO SUR

Maule, Chile

Made from patrimonial grape varieties of Camenere Carignan and Pais. Low intervention wine making with native yeast and fermented in concrete tanks. Brilliant red with violet notes. It presents a complex nose, with red fruits, black pepper and dried herbs. The wine is juicy on the palate with firm tannins with a granular texture.

66. CLOS DU BOIS MERLOT (SP)

USA, California

This deep ruby red Merlot showcases aromas of dark fruit, mocha and toasted oak. Notes of blackberry, plum, and black cherry with hints of vanilla and baking spice are unveiled on the rich, silky palate.

DESSERT WINES

69. PALAZZINA MOSCATO PASSITO (V) (SP)

Italy, Piemonte

A nose of intense lemon curd, marmalade, and orange peel with fragrant honeysuckle notes.

The palate has lots of ripe apricot and acacia honey characters with toffee apple sweetness, well-balanced by a fresh citrus zest bite.

70. M. CHAPOUTIER BANYULS (SP)

France, Rhône Valley

A garnet red colour. With a powerful nose, balancing between black fruits and stewed fruits subtly brought by cocoa aromas.

71. KLEIN CONSTANTIA VIN DE CONSTANCE (SP)

South Africa, Constantia

The nose is layered with Seville orange marmalade, honeysuckle and ginger. Unctuously full bodied with intense flavours ranging from dried mango to fresh vanilla and lively citrus zest and honey.

72. LES GARONNELLES SAUTERNES

France, Bordeaux

An expressive nose with aromas of apricot, ripe pineapple and creme brulee. In the mouth, it is elegant and well balanced, evolving with a long finish full of finesse and acidity to balance the sweetness.
