Sustainability and traceability are becoming more and more important to us and to our guests so look for the symbols below on the list to help you choose a wine most suited to you.

ORGANIC (Org)

Organic Wine is made with no added synthetic pesticides, herbicides or any other chemicals like artificial fertilisers. The wines are accredited by the country's relevant organisation such as The Soil Association of Britain. Many more producers operate to "organic principles" but may be too small or too stubborn to go through the rigorous certification process.

VEGETARIAN (v)

It may seem that a beverage made from pressed and fermented grapes should be vegetarian, but animal derivatives can be used in fining process, such as Isinglass for example.

VEGAN (ve)

It may seem that a beverage made from pressed and fermented grapes should be vegetarian, but animal derivatives can be used in the fining process, such as Isinglass for example.

SUSTAINABLY PRODUCED (SP)

Sustainable Wine growing is a comprehensive set of practices that are environmentally sound, socially equitable and economically viable. They work to conserve energy, maintain healthy soil, protect air and water quality, enhance relations with communities, preserve ecosystems and improve the vitality of vineyards and wineries. Different wine regions have different challenges and each country has their own certifying body.

Champagne Ayala has been specially selected as the House Champagne of Brend Hotels. It is owned by the Bollinger family and is one of the longest established champagne houses, based in the town of Ay since it was founded in 1860. Ayala Champagne was first awarded the Royal Warrant by Edward VIII in 1908 and for over a century Ayala has been the house Champagne of many a British institution.

Ayala Champagne is known for its Chardonnay driven, fresh and elegant wines, crafted on a boutique scale by Caroline Latrive. The low dosage and delicate style make it the perfect epicurean pairing to be enjoyed on any occasion!

01. **AYALA Brut Majeur (SP) France, Champagne**
The nose unveils expressive notes of citrus and white fruits. The style is one of modernity, precision and elegance.

02. **AYALA Rosé Majeur (SP) France, Champagne**
The nose displays aromas of strawberries, raspberries and morello cherries together with nuances of spice. Light, fresh and well-balanced with flavours of red gooseberry and raspberry lingering on the finish.

The nose is aromatic and complex with ripe fruit and spices. Roasted apples, apple compote and peaches burst on the palate. Brioche and walnut linger on the finish. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity.

04. **Bollinger Grande Année (SP) France, Champagne**
The nose is full and expressive. Apricot, almond and hazelnut, followed by notes of honey and pastry intertwining in a symphony of aromas and flavours. Exceptional texture and structure with a long, silky finish.

Australia

Italy, Piemonte

Fresh citrus and stone fruit aromas, with lightly floral notes. The palate has apple and pear characters balanced by hints of apricot, white spice and crisp lemony acidity on the finish.

30. ORUBE RIOJA BLANCO (SP)

Rioja, Spain

White peach and a tropical fruit freshness lead to rich nuttiness and a lick of coconut from the oak. Creamy and unctuous in texture. A real gem.

32. LAURENT MIQUEL 'SOLAS' VIOGNIER

France, Languedoc

Solas Viognier is a well-balanced, food-friendly wine with a medium body and a light bright characteristic fruit flavours of apricot and peach. Aromas of exotic fruit with hints of almond and honeysuckle on the finish.

Italy, Tuscany

A unique wine made from Sangiovese but vinified as a white wine. A delicate floral bouquet, with soft notes of herbs and white fruits. On the palate the wine is fresh, dry and mineral.

Spain, Rias Baixas

Aromas of tropical fruit, green apple, banana and melon. Initially soft on the palate, with a pleasing acidity, which develops into a harmony of fruit dominated by peach.

42. ANDES PEAK MERLOT
Chile
Super smooth with aromas of red fruits, such as strawberries and plums, some spicy notes and a light touch of coffee.

France, Bordeaux
Blason de l'Evangile Pomerol is made from grapes grown in Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafites)'s vineyards with the same care and attention as the Grand Vins but made from the younger vines. This allows for a fresher and less aged style of classic top notch Bordeaux.

A hearty perfume of irises and peonies, the fresh acidity supports a palate of cherries and strawberries with an elegant finish

56. CHÂTEAU CHAMAILLE COTES DU BOURG

Bordeaux, France

In the mouth this red wine is powerful with a nice balance between acidity and tannins.

59. KLEIN CONSTANTIA ESTATE RED BLEND (SP)

South Africa, Constantia

Intense aromas of black and red fruit burst on the nose followed by a delicate wood spice.

The rich and complex palate is balanced with bold tannins and an elegant backbone.

The wine concludes with a long velvety finish.

Spain, Rioja

The nose is bursting with red fruit aromas of cherries, redcurrants and blackberries.

The palate is elegant with lively, fresh flavours. The wood is well-integrated and the finish is persistent.

Spain, Ribera Del Duero

On the palate it is light and soft. Its medium acidity gives it a fresh mouthfeel, without any harshness and well balanced with the alcohol level. It opens up with good levels of pleasant fruitiness. Overall light in the finish.

69. PALAZZINA MOSCATO PASSITO (V) (SP)

Italy, Piemonte

A nose of intense lemon curd, marmalade, and orange peel with fragrant honeysuckle notes. The palate has lots of ripe apricot and acacia honey characters with toffee apple sweetness, well-balanced by a fresh citrus zest bite.

70. M. CHAPOUTIER BANYULS (SP)

France, Rhône Valley

A garnet red colour. With a powerful nose, balancing between black fruits and stewed fruits subtly brought by cocoa aromas.

South Africa, Constantia
